1 On page 3, line 11 of the amendment, after "age" insert ", except
2 that a person who is under twenty-one years of age and at least
3 eighteen years of age, and who is an active duty member of the armed
4 forces of the United States, a member of the national guard or the
5 reserves of the armed forces of the United States, or an honorably
6 discharged veteran, is not ineligible for a concealed pistol license
7 under this subsection (1)(c)"

8 On page 8, after line 4 of the amendment, insert the following:

9 "Sec. 3. RCW 9.41.240 and 1994 sp.s. c 7 s 423 are each amended
10 to read as follows:

11 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, and
12 unless an exception under RCW 9.41.042, 9.41.050, or 9.41.060
13 applies, a person at least eighteen years of age, but less than
14 twenty-one years of age, may possess a pistol only:

15 ((+1)) (a) In the person's place of abode;

16 ((+2)) (b) At the person's fixed place of business; or

17 ((+3)) (c) On real property under his or her control.

18 (2) This section does not apply to a person at least eighteen
19 years of age, but less than twenty-one years of age, who is an active
20 duty member of the armed forces of the United States, a member of the
21 national guard or the reserves of the armed forces of the United
22 States, or an honorably discharged veteran.
