1 On page 8, after line 3, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 7. RCW 19.86.070 and 1961 c 216 s 7 are each amended to
3 read as follows:

4 (1) The labor of a human being is not a commodity or article of
5 commerce. Nothing contained in this chapter shall be construed to
6 forbid the existence and operation of labor, agricultural, or
7 horticultural organizations, instituted for the purposes of mutual
8 help, and not having capital stock or conducted for profit, or to
9 forbid or restrain individual members of such organizations from
10 lawfully carrying out the legitimate objects thereof.

11 (2) This section does not prevent the attorney general or any
12 injured person from bringing a civil action under this chapter
13 against an exclusive bargaining representative that collects union
14 dues without prior written authorization from the employees of its
15 bargaining units for engaging in any unfair or deceptive acts
16 prohibited by this chapter."

EFFECT: Authorizes the attorney general or an injured party to bring a civil action under the Consumer Protection Act for any unfair or deceptive acts engaged in by an exclusive bargaining representative that receives union dues without prior written authorization from the employees of its bargaining units.
