

ESSB 5180 - S AMD 572

ADOPTED AS AMENDED 02/12/2018

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1)(a) Beginning July 1, 2019, the  
4 legislative advisory committee on aging is established, with members  
5 as provided in this subsection.

6 (i) In consultation with the majority and minority leaders, the  
7 president of the senate shall appoint two members from each of the  
8 two largest caucuses of the senate.

9 (ii) In consultation with the majority and minority leaders, the  
10 speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint two members  
11 from each of the two largest caucuses of the house of  
12 representatives.

13 (iii) The department of social and health services and the health  
14 care authority shall cooperate with the committee and maintain  
15 liaison representatives, who are nonvoting members.

16 (b) The committee shall choose its cochairs from among its  
17 legislative membership. The members representing the majority caucus  
18 of the senate shall convene the initial meeting of the committee.

19 (c) The committee, where appropriate, may consult with  
20 individuals from the public and private sector or ask the individuals  
21 to establish an advisory committee. Members of such an advisory  
22 committee are not entitled to expense reimbursement.

23 (2) The committee may review issues of importance to the state's  
24 aging community as well as issues of importance to individuals with  
25 disabilities in Washington. These may include housing issues, long-  
26 term care issues, health and wellness issues, transportation issues,  
27 financial issues, and other issues determined by the committee.

28 (3) Staff support for the committee shall be provided by the  
29 senate committee services and the house of representatives office of  
30 program research.

31 (4) Legislative members of the committee are reimbursed for  
32 travel expenses in accordance with RCW 44.04.120. Nonlegislative

1 members are not entitled to be reimbursed for travel expenses if they  
2 are elected officials or are participating on behalf of an employer,  
3 governmental entity, or other organization. Any reimbursement for  
4 other nonlegislative members is subject to chapter 43.03 RCW.

5 (5) The expenses of the committee shall be paid jointly by the  
6 senate and the house of representatives. Committee expenditures are  
7 subject to approval by the senate facilities and operations committee  
8 and the house of representatives executive rules committee, or their  
9 successor committees.

10 (6) This section expires July 1, 2021."

11 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "aging;" strike the  
12 remainder of the title and insert "creating a new section; and  
13 providing an expiration date."

EFFECT: Requires the president of the senate to appoint two  
members from each of the two largest caucuses of the senate to the  
Legislative Advisory Committee. Specifies the committee will be  
established on July 1, 2019, and extends the section expiration date  
to July 1, 2021.
