- 10 On page 7, line 6, after "(b)" insert "Prior to filing a
- 11 complaint with the ombuds, an inmate shall have reasonably pursued
- 12 resolution of the complaint through the internal grievance process
- 13 with the department of corrections. However, in no event may an
- 14 inmate be prevented from filing a complaint more than ninety days
- 15 after filing an internal grievance, regardless of whether the
- 16 department has completed the grievance process. This subsection
- 17 (2)(b) does not apply to complaints related to threats of bodily harm
- 18 including, but not limited to, sexual or physical assaults or the
- 19 denial of necessary medical treatment.

- 21 Reletter the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any
- 22 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Removes the requirement that the Governor appoint a central corrections ombuds, thereby clarifying that all duties of the corrections ombuds will be the responsibility of the Office of Corrections Ombuds identified by the State Auditor's office; clarifies appropriations provisions relating to the Office of Corrections Ombuds; and requires an inmate to exhaust the internal

grievance procedure with DOC prior to filing a complaint with the ombuds.

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
