In 7 8 exceptional cases, people of unusual competence but without certification may teach students so long as a certificated person 9 10 exercises general supervision, but the hiring of such classified employees shall not occur during a labor dispute, and such classified 11 employees shall not be hired to replace certificated employees during 12 13 a labor dispute."
- Beginning on page 68, line 37, strike all of section 803
