## <u>SSB 5700</u> - S AMD **595** By Senator Ranker

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## ADOPTED 02/12/2018

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "Sec. 1. RCW 74.39A.341 and 2015 c 152 s 3 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 (1) All long-term care workers shall complete twelve hours of 6 continuing education training in advanced training topics each year. 7 ((This requirement applies beginning July 1, 2012.))
  - (2) Of the twelve hours of continuing education training required by subsection (1) of this section, time must be allocated, as established by the department in rule, to provide cultural competency training on issues relating to the LGBTO population as follows:
- 12 <u>(a) Long-term care workers who are licensed on or after the</u>
  13 <u>effective date of this section must complete the one-time training by</u>
  14 their next continuing education due date after December 31, 2019;
- 15 <u>(b) After completing the one-time training, long-term care</u>

- $((\frac{3}{3}))$  (4) Unless voluntarily certified as a home care aide under chapter 18.88B RCW, subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:
- 27 (a) An individual provider caring only for his or her biological, 28 step, or adoptive child;
- 29 (b) Registered nurses and licensed practical nurses licensed 30 under chapter 18.79 RCW;
- 31 (c) ((Before January 1, 2016, a long-term care worker employed by a community residential service business;

- 1 (d))) A person working as an individual provider who provides 2 twenty hours or less of care for one person in any calendar month; or
- $((\frac{(e)}{(e)}))$  (d) A person working as an individual provider who only provides respite services and works less than three hundred hours in any calendar year.

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- ((4))) (5) Only training curriculum approved by the department may be used to fulfill the training requirements specified in this section. The department shall only approve training curriculum that:
- 9 (a) Has been developed with input from consumer and worker 10 representatives; ((and))
- 11 (b) Requires comprehensive instruction by qualified instructors:

- (c) For the one-time training described in subsection (2) of this section, contributes to an evidence and outcome-based approach, and meets the training's learning objectives that will be defined in rule.
- 17 (((+5))) (6) Individual providers under RCW 74.39A.270 shall be compensated for training time required by this section.
- 19  $((\frac{(+6)}{(+6)}))$  The department of health shall adopt rules to 20 implement subsection (1) of this section.
- 21  $((\frac{7}{}))$  (8) The department shall adopt rules to implement 22 subsections (2) and (3) of this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 70.128 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) Adult family home owners and resident managers must complete a one-time department-approved cultural competency training relating to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning (LGBTQ) population. The department must approve the training curriculum, program, and instructors required by this section, and develop a form home owners and resident managers may use for self-reporting completion of this requirement.
- 32 (2) The training required by this section must be completed as 33 follows:
- 34 (a) Adult family home owners and resident managers of adult 35 family homes that are licensed on the effective date of this section 36 must complete the one-time training by the facility's next license 37 renewal after December 31, 2019;

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1 section must complete the training by the time of the facility's 2 first license renewal;

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- (c) Adult family home owners who work on-site of the facility less than two days per license year are not required to complete the training;

If 9 there are approved changes to the learning objectives, adult family 10 home owners, resident managers, and all long-term care workers, must 11 12 take a new training as set forth in the Washington Administrative 13 Code.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 18.20 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) Assisted living facility owners and administrators must complete a one-time department-approved cultural competency training relating to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning (LGBTQ) population. The department must approve the training curriculum, program, and instructors required by this section, and develop a form facility owners and administrators may use for self-reporting completion of this requirement.
- 23 (2) The training required by this section must be completed as 24 follows:
  - (a) Owners and administrators of assisted living facilities that are licensed on the effective date of this section must complete the one-time training by the time of the facility's next license renewal after December 31, 2019;
- 29 (b) Owners and administrators of assisted living facilities that 30 become licensed after the effective date of this section must 31 complete the training by the time of the facility's first license 32 renewal;
- 33 (c) Assisted living facility owners who work on-site of the 34 facility less than two days per license year are not required to 35 complete the training;
- 36 (d) After completing the one-time training, assisted living 37 facility owners and administrators are not required to take the 38 training again until the department approves changes to the learning 39 objectives as established in the Washington Administrative Code. - 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 18.51 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Nursing home owners and administrators must complete a one-
- 8 time department-approved cultural competency training relating to the
- 9 lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning (LGBTQ) population.
- 10 The department must approve the training curriculum, program, and
- 11 instructors required by this section, and develop a form home owners
- 12 and administrators may use for self-reporting completion of this
- 13 requirement.
- 14 (2) The training required by this section must be completed as 15 follows:
- 16 (a) Owners and administrators of nursing homes that are licensed
- 17 on the effective date of this section must complete the one-time

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On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "population;" strike the remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 74.39A.341; adding a new section to chapter 70.128 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 18.20 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 18.51 RCW."

EFFECT: Requires DSHS to establish the specific hour requirement for training in rule; requires both the facility owner and the administrator to complete the training unless the facility owner works on-site less than 2 days per license year; makes a technical fix that requires nursing home owners and administrators of new facilities to take the training by the facility's first license renewal date; requires all long-term care workers that are required to take continuing education to complete the training; corrects a technical issue so that individual providers caring for a parent are required to complete continuing education; extends the training due date from August 1, 2019, to December 31, 2019.

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
