 - $\underline{\text{EFFECT:}}$ (1) Clarifies that treasurers and deputy treasurers of candidates or committees receiving \$5,000 or less must file their name and address with the Public Disclosure Commission.
 - (2) Exempts treasurers or deputy treasurers who will not receive more than nominal compensation from the requirement to complete training.
