- 7 NEW SECTION. (1) Any charter, ordinance, regulation, Sec. 1. rule, or resolution enacted by any city, town, county, or 8 9 district and regulating hours of work, work schedule, work 10 schedule changes must apply equally to both unionized and 11 nonunionized employers.
- (2) No charter, ordinance, regulation, rule, or resolution enacted by any city, town, county, or port district and regulating hours of work, work schedule, or work schedule changes may permit its requirements to be waived, in whole or in part, in collective bargaining.

- 1 (a) "Work schedule" means the hours, days, and times, including 2 regular and on-call shifts, when the employee is required by the 3 employer to perform duties of employment for which the employee will 4 receive compensation for a given period of time; and
- 5 (b) "Work schedule changes" means any modification to the 6 employee's work schedule including, but not limited to: The addition 7 or reduction of hours, cancellation of a work shift or portion of a 8 work shift, a change in the date or time of the work shift, or 9 scheduling the employee for an on-call shift for which the employee 10 does not need to report to work.
