- 1 AN ACT Relating to damages for wage violations; amending RCW
- 2 49.52.070; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.52.070 and 2010 c 8 s 12056 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- Any employer and any officer, vice principal or agent of any employer who shall violate any of the provisions of RCW 49.52.050 (1)
- 8 and (2) shall be liable in a civil action by the aggrieved employee
- 9 or his or her assignee to judgment for ((twice)) the amount of the
- 10 wages unlawfully rebated or withheld plus twice that amount by way of
- 11 exemplary damages, together with costs of suit and a reasonable sum
- 12 for attorney's fees((: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That the benefits of this
- 13 section shall not be available to any employee who has knowingly
- 14 submitted to such violations)).
