- 6 (1) Whenever there exists upon the right-of-way of any county 7 road or bridge, or off the right-of-way thereof in sufficiently close proximity thereto, any structure, device, or natural or artificial 8 9 thing that threatens or endangers the county road or bridge or any portion thereof, that tends to endanger persons traveling thereon, or 10 11 that obstructs or tends to obstruct or constitutes a hazard to vehicles or persons traveling thereon, the structure, device, 12 13 natural or artificial thing is declared to be a public nuisance, and 14 the county may take such action as may be necessary to effect its abatement. Any such structure, device, or natural or artificial thing 15 16 considered by the county to be immediately or eminently dangerous to 17 travel upon a county road or bridge may be immediately removed, and 18 the removal in no event constitutes a breach of the peace or
