- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.04
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 The term "employment" does not include services performed by
- individuals age fourteen to twenty-two years. This exclusion applies 8
- only to the determination of whether state unemployment tax premiums 9
- 10 are owed pursuant to chapter 50.24 RCW. Ιt does not
- eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits for 11 workers age
- 12 fourteen to twenty-two years under chapter 50.20 RCW.
- 13 Sec. 2. If any part of this act is found to be in NEW SECTION.
- conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to 14
- 15 the allocation of federal funds to the state or the eligibility of
- 16 employers in this state for federal unemployment tax credits, the
- 17 conflicting part of this act is inoperative solely to the extent of
- the conflict, and the finding or determination does not affect the 18
- operation of the remainder of this act. Rules adopted under this act 19
- 20 must meet federal requirements that are a necessary condition to the

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- 1 receipt of federal funds by the state or the granting of federal
- 2 unemployment tax credits to employers in this state.

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
