1 AN ACT Relating to the state fungi; adding a new section to 2 chapter 1.20 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature of the state of Washington acknowledges that the pine mushroom, *Tricholoma magnivelare*, notably sought after for its distinct smell and delicious flavor, is an important part of the Washington state ecosystem due to its integral relationship with Washington state forests.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW 10 to read as follows:

11 The pine mushroom, *Tricholoma magnivelare*, is hereby designated 12 as the official state fungi of the state of Washington.
