1 AN ACT Relating to vehicle identification of electrical 2 contractors; and adding a new section to chapter 19.28 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 19.28
RCW to be codified between RCW 19.28.041 and 19.28.141 to read as
follows:

7 (1) Any licensed self-propelled motor vehicle used by a general 8 or specialty electrical contractor while engaged in the electrical 9 construction trade must be marked with the contractor's legal 10 business name and license number issued by the department.

11 (2) The marking must:

12 (a) Appear on both sides of the vehicle;

(b) Be in letters that contrast sharply in color with thebackground on which the letters are placed;

15 (c) Be readily legible during daylight hours from a distance of 16 fifty feet while the vehicle is stationary; and

17 (d) Be kept and maintained in a manner that retains the 18 legibility required by (c) of this subsection.

1 (3) The marking may be affixed by adhesive, painted on the 2 vehicle, or consist of a removable device, if the other requirements 3 of this section are met.
