- 1 AN ACT Relating to limiting disclosure of information about the
- 2 religious affiliation of individuals; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 49.60 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.60 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The legislature finds:
- 8 (a) Washington state celebrates the rich cultural heritage and 9 diversity of its residents;
- 10 (b) Freedom of religion and protection from persecution on the 11 basis of religion is one of the founding ideals of the nation; and
- (c) Washington must uphold the protection of religious freedom enshrined in the United States Constitution for all of its people, and the state has a moral obligation to protect its citizens from
- 15 religious persecution.
- 16 (2) An agency shall not provide or disclose to federal 17 authorities personal information regarding the religious affiliation
- 18 of any individual that is requested for the purpose of compiling a
- 19 database of individuals based solely on religious affiliation.
