- 1 AN ACT Relating to homeschooling foster youth; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 74.15 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** In August 2016, the department of social
- 5 and health services proposed changes to foster parent licensing
- 6 forbidding the provision of home-based instruction to all children in
- 7 the care and custody of the department. This rule was made effective
- 8 September 19, 2016, as WAC 388-148-1525.
- 9 As home-based instruction can be an appropriate and effective
- 10 educational model for foster youth, the legislature intends to
- 11 reverse WAC 388-148-1525(1)(b) and allow foster parents to provide
- 12 home-based instruction to foster youth.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 74.15
- 14 RCW to read as follows:
- 15 The department shall not deny a foster-family home license on the
- 16 sole basis that a foster youth in his or her care received home-based
- instruction as described in RCW 28A.225.010(4).
