- 1 AN ACT Relating to the services and processes available when
- 2 residential real property is abandoned or in foreclosure; adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 43.180 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that there are
- 6 issues that should be addressed with respect to residential property,
- 7 and the services and processes available when such property is
- 8 abandoned or in foreclosure. One issue concerns making changes to the
- 9 law in order that services such as housing counseling, mediation,
- 10 legal services, and consumer protection remain available and that the
- 11 provision of these services is financially viable. Another issue
- 12 concerns what processes and procedures should be put in place to
- 13 address abandoned properties in order to avoid, or remediate in a
- 14 timely manner, problems caused by events, such as extreme weather
- 15 conditions and vandalism, while continuing to respect the rights of
- 16 the homeowner.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.180
- 18 RCW to read as follows:

p. 1 HB 2057

The commission must create a process by which entities, such as servicers, may apply to obtain a certificate of abandonment for properties that meet the definition of abandoned.
