- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. (1) In accordance with Article VII, 5 NEW SECTION. 6 section 12 of the state Constitution, if the governor declares a state of emergency resulting from a catastrophic event 7 necessitates government action to protect life or public safety, then 8 for that fiscal year moneys may be withdrawn and appropriated from 9 10 the budget stabilization account, via separate legislation setting 11 forth the nature of the emergency and containing an appropriation limited to the purposes contained in the declaration, by a favorable 12 13 vote of a majority of the members elected to each house of the legislature. 14
  - (2) Consistent with subsection (1) of this section, for fiscal year 2016 the legislature appropriated \$34,365,000 from the budget stabilization account for the Washington state patrol to cover costs for the 2015 wildfires that were subject to a governor state of emergency declaration.
- 20 (3) Due to the timing of receiving invoices from those events, 21 the Washington state patrol did not expend its entire fiscal year

- 1 2016 budget stabilization account appropriation and therefore needs a
- 2 portion of those moneys reappropriated into fiscal year 2017.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** FOR THE WASHINGTON STATE PATROL—FIRES. The
- 4 sum of \$14,500,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 5 appropriated from the budget stabilization account for the fiscal
- 6 year ending June 30, 2017, and is provided solely for Washington
- 7 state fire service resource mobilization costs incurred in response
- 8 to an emergency or disaster authorized under RCW 43.43.960 through
- 9 43.43.964 for wildfires.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** FOR THE DISASTER RESPONSE ACCOUNT. The sum
- of \$12,500,000 is appropriated from the budget stabilization account
- 12 for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2019, solely for expenditure
- 13 into the disaster response account, and is provided solely for
- 14 disaster response and recovery efforts.
- 15 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES—
- 16 FIRES. The sum of \$20,923,000 is appropriated from the budget
- 17 stabilization account for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, and
- 18 is provided solely for fire suppression costs incurred by the
- 19 department of natural resources during the 2016 fire season.
- 20 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 21 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
- 22 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes
- 23 effect immediately.
