- 2 being required for certain health professions; amending RCW 18.71.010
- 3 and 18.57.001; adding a new section to chapter 18.71 RCW; and adding
- 4 a new section to chapter 18.57 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.71.010 and 1994 sp.s. c 9 s 302 are each amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The following terms used in this chapter shall have the meanings 9 set forth in this section unless the context clearly indicates 10 otherwise:
- 11 (1) "Commission" means the Washington state medical quality 12 assurance commission.
- 13 (2) (("Secretary" means the secretary of health.
- 14 (3)) "Emergency medical care" or "emergency medical service" has
 15 the same meaning as in chapter 18.73 RCW.
- 16 (3) "Maintenance of certification" means the satisfactory
- 17 participation in a formal recertification program to maintain board
- 18 certification after initial certification from the American board of
- 19 medical specialties or other accrediting organization recognized by
- 20 the commission.

- 1 (4) "Resident physician" means an individual who has graduated from a school of medicine which meets the requirements set forth in RCW 18.71.055 and is serving a period of postgraduate clinical 3 medical training sponsored by a college or university in this state 4 or by a hospital accredited by this state. For purposes of this 6 chapter, the term shall include individuals designated as intern or 7 medical fellow.
- (((4) "Emergency medical care" or "emergency medical service" has 8 9 the same meaning as in chapter 18.73 RCW.))
- (5) "Secretary" means the secretary of health. 10
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 18.71 11 RCW to read as follows: 12
- 13 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the commission may not require a physician to participate in a 14 15 maintenance of certification requirement as a condition of licensure 16 or license renewal. The commission may allow a physician to fulfill 17 license renewal requirements through satisfactory participation in a 18 recognized maintenance of certification program.
- 19 (2) This section does not apply to board certification 20 requirements or maintenance of certification requirements included in 21 any of the following:
 - (a) A stipulation to informal disposition under RCW 18.130.172;
- 23 (b) An order issued to resolve a statement of charges under RCW 24 18.130.090;
 - (c) An order issued under RCW 18.130.160; or
- (d) A reinstatement order issued under RCW 18.130.150. 26

- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 18.57 9 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the board may not require an osteopathic physician and surgeon to participate in a maintenance of certification requirement as a condition of licensure or license renewal. The board may allow a physician to fulfill license renewal requirements through satisfactory participation in a recognized maintenance of certification program.
- 17 (2) This section does not apply to board certification 18 requirements or maintenance of certification requirements included in 19 any of the following:
- 20 (a) A stipulation to informal disposition under RCW 18.130.172;
- 21 (b) An order issued to resolve a statement of charges under RCW 22 18.130.090;
- 23 (c) An order issued under RCW 18.130.160; or
- 24 (d) A reinstatement order issued under RCW 18.130.150.
