- 1 AN ACT Relating to protecting consumers from excess charges for
- 2 prescription medications; adding a new section to chapter 19.340 RCW;

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.340 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A contract entered into or renewed on or after the effective 8 date of this section between a pharmacy benefit manager or insurer 9 and a pharmacist or pharmacy may not penalize, including through 10 increased utilization review, reduced payments, or other financial 11 disincentives, a pharmacist's or pharmacy's disclosure to a person 12 purchasing prescription medication of information regarding:
  - (a) The cost of the prescription medication to the person; or
- 14 (b) The availability of any therapeutically equivalent 15 alternative medications or alternative methods of purchasing the 16 prescription medication, including, but not limited to, paying the 17 cash price, that are less expensive than the cost of the prescription 18 medication to the person.
- 19 (2) On or after January 1, 2019, the maximum amount a pharmacy 20 benefit manager or insurer may require a person to pay at the point 21 of sale for a covered prescription medication is the lesser of:

- (c) The amount the person would pay for the prescription medication if the person purchased the prescription medication without using a health plan or any other source of prescription medication benefits or discounts.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act may be known and cited as the affordable medication for patients act.
