1 AN ACT Relating to railroad community notice requirements; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 81.48 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 81.48
RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) At least ten days prior to taking any planned action that may 7 have a significant impact on a community, railroad companies must 8 notify, in writing, the governing authority of the community and the 9 commission of the planned action.

10 (2) The notice must contain a heading with the words "important 11 notice" in prominent type and contain, at a minimum, the following:

12 (a) Date the notice is issued;

13 (b) A clear explanation of the type of planned event;

14 (c) Specific location of the event;

15 (d) An estimation of the start and completion date of the event;

16 (e) Any additional information that will assist the community to 17 plan for the event; and

18 (f) Railroad company contact person and phone number.

(3) If a railroad company fails to notify the governing authority of the community and the commission of the planned action, the commission may pursue the following to the maximum extent permitted 1 under federal law: Administrative actions including, but not limited 2 to, issuing defect notices to railroad companies, reports and 3 recommendations to the federal railroad administration, warnings, 4 sanctions, and penalty assessments.
