- AN ACT Relating to certificates of veterinary inspection for animals brought into the state; and amending RCW 16.36.140.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 16.36.140 and 2011 c 204 s 12 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) It is unlawful for a person to bring an animal into 7 Washington state without first securing a certificate of veterinary 8 inspection, reviewed by the state veterinarian of the state of 9 origin, verifying that the animal meets Washington state animal 10 health requirements. This subsection does not apply to animals that:
- 11 (a) Have been exempted by the director by rule; or
- 12 (b) Will be delivered within twelve hours after entry into 13 Washington state to:
- 14 (i) ((An approved, inspected feed lot for slaughter;
- 15 (ii)) A federally inspected slaughter plant; or
- 16  $((\frac{(iii)}{)})$  (ii) A licensed public livestock market for sale and subsequent delivery within twelve hours to(( $\div$
- 18 (A) An approved, inspected feed lot for slaughter; or
- (B)) a federally inspected slaughter plant.

1 (2) The director may monitor animals entering Washington state. 2 Persons importing, transporting, receiving, feeding, or housing 3 imported animals shall:

- (a) Comply with the requirement and any exemptions specified in subsection (1) of this section; and
- 6 (b) Make the animal and related records available for inspection 7 by the director.
- 8 (3) The director may adopt and enforce rules necessary to carry 9 out the purpose and provisions of this section.
