1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting marijuana licensees from engaging 2 in activities that can be seen or smelled from public places or 3 nearby properties; and adding a new section to chapter 69.50 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 69.50 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A producer, processor, or research entity licensed under this 8 chapter is prohibited from engaging in any marijuana production, 9 processing, or storage activity that can either be readily seen by 10 normal unaided vision, or readily smelled, from a public place or 11 private property on which a housing unit is located.

12 (2) Cities, towns, and counties may enact and enforce ordinances 13 creating civil penalties and legal remedies, including abatement 14 procedures, for the growing, processing, or storage of marijuana in 15 violation of the provisions of this section.
