AN ACT Relating to utility service annexation covenants; adding a new section to chapter 35.21 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 3 35A.21 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 35.21 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A city may not require the owner of a property located 8 outside its corporate limits to enter into a utility service 9 annexation covenant as a condition of extending utilities to such 10 property.

(2) Nothing in this section should be interpreted as requiring acity to extend utilities to property outside its corporate limits.

13 (3) Nothing in RCW 35.84.010, 35.91.020, 35.21.210, 35.67.310, or 14 other applicable laws granting contracting authority to a city allows 15 a city to require the owner of a property located outside its 16 corporate limits to enter into a utility service annexation covenant 17 as a condition of extending utilities to such property.

18 (4) For purposes of this section, a "utility service annexation 19 covenant" means a contract between a city and a property owner 20 located in another city, town, or unincorporated area wherein the 21 city agrees to provide utility service or services to the property in exchange for a promise that the property owner or owners, whenever requested, sign any letter, notice, petition, or other instrument under applicable laws of the state of Washington initiating, furthering, or accomplishing annexation of the property into the city.

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 35A.21 7 RCW to read as follows:

8 (1) A city may not require the owner of a property located 9 outside its corporate limits to enter into a utility service 10 annexation covenant as a condition of extending utilities to such 11 property.

12 (2) Nothing in this section should be interpreted as requiring a13 city to extend utilities to property outside its corporate limits.

14 (3) Nothing in RCW 35.84.010, 35.91.020, 35.21.210, 35.67.310, or
15 other applicable laws granting contracting authority to a city allows
16 a city to require the owner of a property located outside its
17 corporate limits to enter into a utility service annexation covenant
18 as a condition of extending utilities to such property.

(4) For purposes of this section, a "utility service annexation 19 20 covenant" means a contract between a city and a property owner 21 located in another city, town, or unincorporated area wherein the city agrees to provide utility service or services to the property in 22 23 exchange for a promise that the property owner or owners, whenever requested, sign any letter, notice, petition, or other instrument 24 25 under applicable laws of the state of Washington initiating, 26 furthering, or accomplishing annexation of the property into the 27 city.
