1            AN ACT Relating to the crime of endangerment with a controlled  
2 substance; amending RCW 9A.42.100; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.42.100 and 2005 c 218 s 4 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6            (1) A person is guilty of the crime of endangerment with a  
7 controlled substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits  
8 a dependent child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest,  
9 inhale, or have contact with (~~methamphetamine~~):

10            (a) Any controlled substance listed in Schedule I under RCW  
11 69.50.204 or in Schedule II under RCW 69.50.206, unless the exposure,  
12 ingestion, inhalation, or contact is in accordance with a valid  
13 prescription or order; or

14            (b) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous ammonia, including  
15 their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that are being used in  
16 the manufacture of methamphetamine, including its salts, isomers, and  
17 salts of isomers.

18            (2) Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class B felony.
