- AN ACT Relating to modifying the requirements of agendas posted 1 2 under the open public meetings act; amending RCW 42.30.077 and
- 3 42.30.060; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.30.077 and 2014 c 61 s 2 are each amended to read 5 6 as follows:
- Public agencies with governing bodies must make the agenda of 7 each regular meeting of the governing body available online no later 8
- than ((twenty-four)) seventy-two hours in advance of the published 9
- 10 start time of the meeting. Subsequent modifications to the agenda
- 11 must be posted no later than forty-eight hours in advance of the
- published start time of the meeting. The agenda must include a direct 12
- link to the minutes of the governing body's previous meetings. An 13
- 14 agency subject to provisions of this section is not required to post
- an agenda if it does not have a web site or if it employs fewer than 15
- 16 ten full-time equivalent employees. ((Nothing in this section
- 17 prohibits subsequent modifications to agendas nor invalidates any
- otherwise legal)) Consistent with RCW 42.30.060, any final action 18
- taken at a meeting where the agenda was not posted in accordance with 20
- this section((. Nothing in this section modifies notice requirements
- 21 or shall be construed as establishing)) is null and void. This

- 1 <u>section does not establish</u> that a public body or agency's online
- 2 posting of an agenda as required by this section is sufficient notice
- 3 to satisfy public notice requirements established under other laws.
- 4 Failure to post an agenda in accordance with this section shall
- 5 ((not)) provide a basis for ((awarding attorney fees under RCW
- 6 42.30.120 or)) commencing an action for mandamus or injunction under
- 7 RCW 42.30.130. A prevailing party in any action in the courts for a
- 8 violation of this section shall not be awarded attorneys' fees under
- 9 RCW 42.30.120.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.30.060 and 1989 c 42 s 1 are each amended to read 11 as follows:
- 12 (1) No governing body of a public agency shall adopt any
- ordinance, resolution, rule, regulation, order, or directive, except in a meeting open to the public of which an agenda has been properly
- in a meeting open to the public of which an agenda has been properly posted in accordance with RCW 42.30.077, and then only at a meeting,
- 16 the date of which is fixed by law or rule, or at a meeting of which
- 17 notice has been given according to the provisions of this chapter.
- 18 Any action taken at meetings failing to comply with the provisions of
- 10 Any accion taken at meetings railing to comply with the provisions of
- 19 this subsection shall be null and void, except that only final
- 20 actions, as defined in RCW 42.30.020, taken at meetings failing to
- 21 comply with agenda posting requirements under RCW 42.30.077 shall be
- 22 null and void.
- 23 (2) No governing body of a public agency at any meeting required
- 24 to be open to the public shall vote by secret ballot. Any vote taken
- 25 in violation of this subsection shall be null and void, and shall be
- 26 considered an "action" under this chapter.
- 27 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2019.
