AN ACT Relating to providing a sales and use tax exemption for diapers; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and creating new sections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) This section is the tax preference 6 performance statement for the sales and use tax exemptions for diapers established in sections 2 and 3, chapter . . ., Laws of 2018 7 (sections 2 and 3 of this act). This performance statement is only 8 intended to be used for subsequent evaluation of the tax preferences. 9 10 It is not intended to create a private right of action by any party 11 or be used to determine eligibility for preferential tax treatment.
- 12 (2) The legislature categorizes this tax preference as one 13 intended to provide tax relief for certain individuals as indicated 14 in RCW 82.32.808(2)(e).
 - (3) It is the legislature's specific public policy objective to authorize permanent sales and use tax exemptions for the purchase of diapers in order to lessen the tax burden on Washington families.
 - (4) Because the legislature intends for these tax preferences to be permanent, the joint legislative audit and review committee is not required to perform a tax preference review; however, these tax

- 1 preferences must be included in the tax exemption report required
- 2 under RCW 43.06.400 published by the department of revenue.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 4 RCW to read as follows:
- 5 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to the sales 6 of diapers.
- 7 (2) For the purposes of this section, "diaper" means an absorbent
- 8 incontinence product that is washable or disposable and is worn by a
- 9 person, regardless of age or sex, who cannot control bladder or bowel
- 10 movements.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12
- 12 RCW to read as follows:
- 13 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to
- 14 the use of diapers.
- 15 (2) For the purposes of this section, "diaper" has the same
- 16 meaning as provided in section 2 of this act.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The provisions of RCW 82.32.805(1)(a) do
- 18 not apply to this act.
