1 AN ACT Relating to limiting the application of certain civil 2 penalties to protect landowners from incurring penalties based on the 3 actions of the landowner's lessee; and amending RCW 90.03.600.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 90.03.600 and 2003 1st sp.s. c 15 s 3 are each 6 amended to read as follows:

(1) In determining the amount of a penalty to be levied, the 7 department shall consider the seriousness of the violation, whether 8 the violation is repeated or continuous after notice of the violation 9 10 is given, and whether any damage has occurred to the health or 11 property of other persons. Except as provided in RCW 43.05.060 through 43.05.080 and 43.05.150, the department $\left(\left(\frac{of}{ecology}\right)\right)$ may 12 levy civil penalties ranging from one hundred dollars to five 13 14 thousand dollars per day for violation of any of the provisions of this chapter and chapters 43.83B, 90.22, and 90.44 RCW, and rules, 15 16 permits, and similar documents and regulatory orders of the 17 department ((of ecology)) adopted or issued pursuant to such chapters. The procedures of RCW 90.48.144 shall be applicable to all 18 phases of the levying of a penalty under RCW 90.48.144 as well as 19 20 review and appeal of the same.
