3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 10.19.160 and 1986 c 322 s 5 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The surety on the bond may return to custody a person in a 7 criminal case under the surety's bond if the surrender is accompanied by a notice of forfeiture or a notarized affidavit specifying the 8 reasons for the surrender. The surrender shall be made to ((the 9 10 facility in which the person was originally held in custody or)) the 11 county or city jail affiliated with the ((court)) jurisdiction issuing the warrant resulting in bail. Upon surrender, a person must 12 be held until the next judicial day or until another bond is posted. 13
