1 AN ACT Relating to driver's license formats for persons  
2 approaching twenty-one years of age; amending RCW 46.20.105; and  
3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.105 and 2000 c 115 s 5 are each amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 (1)(a) The department may provide a method to distinguish the  
8 driver's license of a person who is under the age of twenty-one from  
9 the driver's license of a person who is twenty-one years of age or  
10 older.

11 (b) The department must allow for a person who applies to renew  
12 his or her driver's license within one week of his or her twenty-  
13 first birthday to convert the driver's license to the format of a  
14 driver's license for a person who is twenty-one years of age or  
15 older.

16 (2) An instruction permit must be identified as an "instruction  
17 permit" and issued in a distinctive form as determined by the  
18 department.

19 (3) An intermediate license must be identified as an  
20 "intermediate license" and issued in a distinctive form as determined  
21 by the department.
