- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.105 and 2000 c 115 s 5 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1)(a) The department may provide a method to distinguish the 8 driver's license of a person who is under the age of twenty-one from 9 the driver's license of a person who is twenty-one years of age or 10 older.
- 11 (b) The department must allow for a person who applies to renew
- 12 <u>his or her driver's license within one week of his or her twenty-</u>
- 13 first birthday to convert the driver's license to the format of a
- 14 <u>driver's license for a person who is twenty-one years of age or</u>
- 15 older.
- 16 (2) An instruction permit must be identified as an "instruction
- 17 permit" and issued in a distinctive form as determined by the
- 18 department.
- 19 (3) An intermediate license must be identified as an
- 20 "intermediate license" and issued in a distinctive form as determined
- 21 by the department.
