- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.24.350 and 1997 c 321 s 20 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1)(a) There shall be a <u>wine and</u> beer retailer's license to be designated as a snack bar license to sell <u>at retail</u>, <u>wine by the glass and</u> beer by the opened bottle or can ((at retail,)). The beverages are only for consumption upon the premises ((only, such
- 10 license to)).
 - 11 (b) The license may be issued to a business whose main purpose is
 - 12 to provide instruction to their customers and where customers
 - 13 participate in art activities such as painting, pottery, or
 - 14 sculpting. The business must meet all other requirements of this
 - 15 section.
 - 16 (2) The licenses may only be issued to places where the sale of
 - 17 <u>wine or</u> beer is not the principal business ((conducted; fee)).
 - 18 (3) The wine and beer must be consumed in a designated seating
 - 19 area, which may include an area where an instructor leads group
 - 20 activities.
