- 1 AN ACT Relating to snack bar licenses; and amending RCW
- 2 66.24.350.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.24.350 and 1997 c 321 s 20 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1) There shall be a <u>wine and</u> beer retailer's license to be designated as a snack bar license to sell <u>at retail</u>, <u>wine by the glass and</u> beer by the opened bottle or can ((at retail,)). The beverages are only for consumption upon the premises ((only, such
- 10 license to)).
- 11 (2) The licenses may only be issued to places where the sale of wine or beer is not the principal business ((conducted; fee)).
- 13 (3) The wine and beer must be consumed in a designated seating
- 14 area, which may include an area where an instructor leads group
- 15 activities.
- 16 <u>(4) The license fee is set at</u> one hundred twenty-five dollars per 17 year.
