- AN ACT Relating to the use of credit cards for purchases of spirits and wine by a purchaser licensed to sell spirits and/or wine for consumption on the licensed premises; and amending RCW 66.28.270.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.28.270 and 2009 c 373 s 11 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) Nothing in this chapter prohibits the use of checks, credit or debit cards, prepaid accounts, electronic funds transfers, and 8 other similar methods as approved by the board, as cash payments for 9 10 purposes of this title. Electronic ((fund[s])) funds transfers must 11 be: $((\frac{1}{1}))$ (a) Voluntary; $((\frac{2}{1}))$ (b) conducted pursuant to a prior written agreement of the parties that includes a provision that the 12 purchase be initiated by an irrevocable invoice or sale order before 13 14 the time of delivery; $((\frac{3}{3}))$ (c) initiated by the retailer, 15 manufacturer, importer, or distributor no later than the first 16 business day following delivery; and $((\frac{4}{1}))$ (d) completed 17 promptly as is reasonably practical, and in no event $((\tau))$ later than 18 five business days following delivery.
- 19 (2) Any person licensed as a distributor of spirits and/or wine 20 may pass credit card fees on to a purchaser licensed to sell spirits 21 and/or wine for consumption on the licensed premises, if the decision

- 1 to use a credit card is entirely voluntary and the credit card fees
- 2 <u>are set out as a separate line item on the distributor's invoice.</u>
- 3 Nothing in this section requires the use of a credit card by any

4 <u>licensee</u>.
