- 1 AN ACT Relating to the applicability of nondisclosure agreements
- 2 in civil actions for sexual harassment or assault; and adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 4.24 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 In any civil action relating to sexual harassment or assault, a
- 8 nondisclosure policy or agreement that purports to limit the ability
- 9 of any person to produce evidence regarding past instances of sexual
- 10 harassment or assault by a party to the civil action does not affect
- 11 discovery or the availability of witness testimony relating to that
- 12 civil action. Any provision of a nondisclosure policy or agreement
- 13 that would limit, prevent, or punish such disclosure is contrary to
- 14 public policy and unenforceable. However, the court shall enter
- 15 appropriate orders to ensure that the identity of any person who is
- 16 or is alleged to be a victim of sexual harassment or assault is not
- 17 made public as a result of a disclosure made under this section,
- 18 unless such person consents.
