4 in education marked by an exceptional commitment to students and  
5 investment in their future; and

6 WHEREAS, Prior to his lifelong career in education, Mr. Groth  
7 graduated from Eastern Washington University with a degree in  
8 Education and went on to earn a Masters of Arts in Teaching from  
9 Grand Canyon College; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Groth taught business education where his first  
11 classroom consisted of 12 manual typewriters and two brand new  
12 electric typewriters; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Groth worked tirelessly over the years to make  
14 business education relevant for students in an ever-changing  
15 technological environment; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Groth helped create the school website, produced the  
17 school newsletter for over 10 years, helped for years in computer  
18 repairs and ordering, and helped get the school's business program  
19 Microsoft certification testing; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Groth served as athletic director for 17 years and  
21 coached 61 high school sports seasons: 18 years as girls basketball  
22 coach, 6 years as boys assistant basketball, 3 years cross country,

1 and 34 years softball. He took the girls basketball one time to  
2 state and softball 11 times to state; winning the state title in  
3 2007;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State  
5 Senate recognize Charlie Groth for his outstanding 39 years of  
6 service as a teacher and coach at the Curlew School District,  
7 and wish him the very best in his retirement.
