1 AN ACT Relating to the collective bargaining rights of the
2 professional personnel of port districts; and amending RCW 53.18.010
3 and 53.18.060.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.18.010 and 1967 c 101 s 1 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 "Port district" shall mean a municipal corporation of the state
8 of Washington created pursuant to Title 53 RCW. Said port districts
9 may also be hereinafter referred to as the "employer."

10 "Employee" shall include all port employees except managerial(~~(~~
11 ~~professional,~~) and administrative personnel, and their confidential
12 assistants.

13 "Employee organization" means any lawful association, labor
14 organization, union, federation, council, or brotherhood, having as
15 its primary purpose the representation of employees on matters of
16 employment relations.

17 "Employment relations" includes, but is not limited to, matters
18 concerning wages, salaries, hours, vacation, sick leave, holiday pay
19 and grievance procedures.

1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 53.18.060 and 1967 c 101 s 6 are each amended to
2 read as follows:

3 No labor agreement or contract entered into by a port district
4 shall:

5 (1) Restrict the right of the port district in its discretion to
6 hire;

7 (2) Limit the right of the port to secure its regular or steady
8 employees from the local community; (~~and~~)

9 (3) Include within the same agreements: (a) Port security
10 personnel(~~, or~~) and (b) port supervisory personnel; and

11 (4) Include within the same bargaining unit: (a) Port
12 professional personnel and (b) port supervisory personnel.
