(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Requires the chief of the Washington state patrol, through the director of fire protection, to administer the national fire incident reporting system including purchasing equipment, establishing procedures, standards, and guidelines, providing training and education, and employing staff.

Requires rules established by the chief of the Washington state patrol, through the director of fire protection, to require fire departments to report data on the age of any structure involved in a fire when that information is available through property records or other methods.

Provides that this act is null and void if appropriations are not approved.
