EFFECT: Decreases funding for the Department of Ecology's implementation of the Clean Air Rule by \$1.8 million. Provides \$0.9 million one-time to the Department of Natural Resources for forest health treatments and prescribed burning. Provides \$0.9 million one-time to the Washington State Patrol to reimburse local fire suppression entities for contracted aircraft costs for fire suppression.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
