1 On page 5, after line 23, insert the following:

3 "(9) (a) Beginning January 1, 2020, a person is exempt from any
4 legal obligation to pay real property taxes due and payable under this
5 section in excess of the amount under this section in the year
6 following the year in which a claim is filed, and thereafter, if the
7 person is indigent.

8 (b) For purposes of this section, "indigent" means a person who
9 is:

10 (i) Receiving one of the following types of public assistance:

11 (A) Temporary assistance for needy families, aged, blind, or
12 disabled assistance benefits, medical care services under RCW
13 74.09.035;

14 (B) Pregnant women assistance benefits;

15 (C) Poverty-related veterans' benefits;

16 (D) Food stamps or food stamp benefits transferred electronically,

17 (E) Refugee resettlement benefits;

18 (F) Medicaid; or

19 (G) Supplemental security income; or

20 (ii) Involuntarily committed to a public mental health facility;

21 or

22 (iii) Receiving an annual income, after taxes, of one hundred
23 twenty-five percent or less of the current federally established
24 poverty level."

EFFECT: Exempts all indigent taxpayers from the increased levy rate, as provided in this bill.

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
