1 On page 25, line 14, increase the general fund—state
2 appropriation for fiscal year 2020 by \$4,000,000

3 On page 25, line 15, increase the general fund—state
4 appropriation for fiscal year 2021 by \$4,000,000

5 On page 26, line 7, correct the total

6 On page 35, after line 15, insert:

7 "(54) \$4,000,000 of the general fund—state appropriation for
8 fiscal year 2020 and \$4,000,000 of the general fund—state
9 appropriation for fiscal year 2021 are provided solely for grants to
10 local government drug and gang task forces."

11 On page 123, line 1, increase the general fund—state
12 appropriation for fiscal year 2020 by \$5,000,000

13 On page 123, line 2, increase the general fund—state
14 appropriation for fiscal year 2021 by \$5,000,000

15 On page 123, line 11, correct the total

16 On page 124, after line 37, insert the following:

17 "(9) \$5,000,000 of the general fund—state appropriation for
18 fiscal year 2020 and \$5,000,000 of the general fund—state
19 appropriation for fiscal year 2021 are provided solely for the
20 Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs to develop and
21 implement a proactive policing grant program.

22 (a) The purpose of the program is to provide additional,
23 nonsupplanted funding to law enforcement agencies to address the
24 public safety needs of their individual communities. The grants must
25 be awarded to local law enforcement agencies based on their locally
26 developed proposals, and two or more agencies may submit a joint
27 grant proposal. A peer review panel appointed by the Washington
28 association of sheriffs and police chiefs must review the grant

1 applications, and association may prioritize grant applications that
2 include local matching funds.

3 (b) To the extent practicable, grants should be awarded on a two-
4 year cycle, and grant proposals must:

5 (i) Demonstrate the public safety problem to be addressed;

6 (ii) Identify the strategy for addressing the problem; and

7 (iii) Identify specific data elements to measure the current
8 state of the problem and whether the actions to address the problem
9 were successful.

10 (c) By December 1st of each year the program is funded, the
11 Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs must submit an
12 annual report to the governor and the appropriate committees of the
13 legislature. The report must include information regarding the grant
14 recipients, the use of funds, and feedback from the grant
15 recipients."

EFFECT: (1) Provides \$8,000,000 for the Department of Commerce to
provide grants to local government drug and gang task forces.

(2) Provides \$10,000,000 to the Criminal Justice Training
Commission for the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police
Chiefs (WASPC) to develop and administer a proactive policing grant
program that provides funding to law enforcement agencies to address
the public safety needs of their individual communities. Requires
WASPC to provide an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature
by December 1st for each year the program is funded.

FISCAL IMPACT: Increases General Fund—State by \$18,000,000.

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
