1 On page 1, line 26, after "RCW" insert "or, if the Washington
2 state apprenticeship and training council denies approval of an
3 apprenticeship program for a contractor who performs work at a
4 facility described in section 2(1) of this act, a federally approved
5 apprenticeship program"

6 On page 2, line 6, after "(a)" strike all material through "RCW"
7 on line 12 and insert "(i) The worker has graduated from an
8 apprenticeship program for the applicable occupation that was
9 approved by the Washington state apprenticeship and training council
10 according to chapter 49.04 RCW or, if the Washington state
11 apprenticeship and training council denies approval of an
12 apprenticeship program for a contractor who performs work at a
13 facility described in section 2(1) of this act, a federally approved
14 apprenticeship program; or

15 (ii) The worker has at least as many hours of on-the-job
16 experience in the applicable occupation that would be required to
17 graduate from an apprenticeship program approved by the Washington
18 state apprenticeship and training council according to chapter 49.04
19 RCW"

20 On page 3, line 31, after "**Sec. 3.**" insert "(1)"

21 On page 3, at the beginning of line 36, strike "(1)(a)" and
22 insert "(a)(i)"

23 On page 4, at the beginning of line 1, strike "(b)" and insert
24 "(ii)"

25 On page 4, at the beginning of line 5, strike "(c)" and insert
26 "(iii)"

1 On page 4, at the beginning of line 10, strike "(d)" and insert
2 "(iv)"

3 On page 4, at the beginning of line 14, strike "(2)" and insert
4 "(b)"

5 On page 4, after line 17, insert the following:

6 "(2) If the Washington state apprenticeship and training council
7 denies approval of an apprenticeship program for a contractor who
8 performs work at a facility described in section 2(1) of this act,
9 workers who graduate from federally approved apprenticeship programs
10 in the applicable occupation satisfy the apprenticeship graduation
11 requirements of subsection (1)(a) of this section."

EFFECT: Allows for apprentices and apprenticeship graduates
of federally approved apprenticeship programs to satisfy the
requirements of the bill if the Washington state apprenticeship and
training council denies approval of an apprenticeship program for a
contractor who performs work at a high hazard facility.
