1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** In 2016, the legislature directed state
4 parks to develop options and recommendations to improve the
5 consistency, equity, and simplicity in recreational access fee
6 systems. This process identified the layering of park permit
7 requirements that apply to sno-parks, and so the legislature intends
8 to address this issue.

9 **Sec. 2.** RCW 79A.80.060 and 2011 c 320 s 7 are each amended to
10 read as follows:

11 The discover pass or the day-use permit are not required, for
12 persons who have a valid sno-park (~~(seasonal)~~) permit issued by the
13 state parks and recreation commission, at designated sno-parks
14 between November 1st through March 31st.

15 **Sec. 3.** RCW 79A.80.010 and 2013 2nd sp.s. c 23 s 22 are each
16 amended to read as follows:

17 The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter
18 unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

19 (1) "Agency" or "agencies" means the department of fish and
20 wildlife, the department of natural resources, and the parks and
21 recreation commission.

22 (2) "Annual natural investment permit" means the annual permit
23 issued by the parks and recreation commission for the purpose of
24 launching boats from the designated state parks boat launch sites.

25 (3) "Camper registration" means proof of payment of a camping fee
26 on recreational lands managed by the parks and recreation commission.

27 (4) "Day-use permit" means the permit created in RCW 79A.80.030.

28 (5) "Discover pass" means the annual pass created in RCW
29 79A.80.020.

1 (6) "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as defined in RCW
2 46.04.320 and which are required to be registered under chapter
3 46.16A RCW. "Motor vehicle" does not include those motor vehicles
4 exempt from registration under RCW 46.16A.080, wheeled all-terrain
5 vehicles registered for use under RCW 46.09.442, and state and
6 publicly owned motor vehicles as provided in RCW 46.16A.170.

7 (7) "Recreation site or lands" means a state park, state lands
8 and state forestlands as those terms are defined in RCW 79.02.010,
9 natural resources conservation areas as that term is defined in RCW
10 79.71.030, natural area preserves as that term is defined in RCW
11 79.70.020, and fish and wildlife conservation sites including water
12 access areas, boat ramps, wildlife areas, parking areas, roads, and
13 trailheads.

14 (8) "Sno-park (~~seasonal~~) permit" means the (~~seasonal~~) permit
15 issued by the parks and recreation commission for providing access to
16 winter recreational facilities for the period of November 1st through
17 March 31st.

18 (9) "Vehicle access pass" means the pass created in RCW
19 79A.80.040."

21 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 79A.80.060 and
22 79A.80.010; and creating a new section."
