- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The Washington state patrol must convene a stakeholder work group to analyze and develop options for 4 addressing the temporary use of cargo carrying devices, the laws 5 governing license plate visibility, and any officer and public safety 6 issues with allowing the rear license plate to be blocked by these 7 devices. At a minimum, a representative from each of the following 8 groups must be invited to participate: The Washington association of 9 sheriffs and police chiefs; a bicycle advocacy organization; an 10 11 advocacy organization supporting the rights of persons 12 disability; and the department of licensing.
 - (2) The work group must provide a recommendation on how to address temporary use of cargo carrying devices that block the license plate to the transportation committees of the legislature by December 1, 2020.
- 17 (3) This section expires June 30, 2021."

- On page 1, line 3 of the title, after "devices;" strike the remainder of the title and insert "creating a new section; and providing an expiration date."
 - $\underline{\text{EFFECT:}}$ (1) Removes the language authorizing the temporary obstruction of a license plate by a cargo carrying device.
 - (2) Requires the Washington State Patrol to convene a work group to develop policy options for the temporary use of a cargo carrying device that address concerns with officer and public safety. A report

with any recommendations is due to the legislature by December 1, 2020.
