## SHB 2632 - S AMD 1360 By Senator Pedersen

## ADOPTED 03/10/2020

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes that false 3 reporting laws criminalize the knowingly false reporting of certain 4 occurrences that are likely to cause unwarranted evacuations, public 5 inconvenience, or alarm. Recently, however, false reporting and the 6 7 911 system have been weaponized, resulting in serious dangers and even lost lives. The term "swatting" describes the false reporting of 8 an emergency with the goal of having a police unit or special weapons 9 and tactics team deployed. The reckless act of swatting, often 10 11 motivated by the perpetrator's bias towards protected classes, has 12 caused death and trauma in some cases. As such, the legislature finds that a gross misdemeanor is insufficient as a legal response and 13 14 hereby create felony false reporting punishments when the false reporting leads to injury or death. 15
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.84.040 and 2011 c 336 s 411 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1) A person ((is quilty of)) commits false reporting if, with 18 knowledge that the information reported, conveyed, or circulated is 19 20 false, he or she initiates or circulates a false report or warning of 21 an alleged occurrence or impending occurrence ((of a fire, explosion, 22 crime, catastrophe, or emergency)) knowing that such false report is likely to cause ((evacuation)): Evacuation of a building, place of 23 24 assembly, or transportation facility((, or to cause)); public 25 inconvenience or alarm; or an emergency response.
- 26 (2) (a) A person is quilty of false reporting in the first degree 27 if the report was made with reckless disregard for the safety of 28 others, the false reporting caused an emergency response, and death 29 is sustained by any person as a proximate result of an emergency 30 response. False reporting in the first degree is a class B felony.

- (b) A person is guilty of false reporting in the second degree if
  the report was made with reckless disregard for the safety of others,
  the false reporting caused an emergency response, and substantial
  bodily harm is sustained by any person as a proximate result of an
  emergency response. False reporting in the second degree is a class C
  felony.
  - (c) A person is guilty of false reporting in the third degree if he or she commits false reporting under circumstances not constituting false reporting in the first or second degree. False reporting in the third degree is a gross misdemeanor.

- 11 (3) Any criminal offense committed under this section may be
  12 deemed to have been committed either at the place from which the
  13 false report was made, at the place where the false report was
  14 received by law enforcement, or at the place where an evacuation,
  15 public inconvenience or alarm, or emergency response occurred.
  - (4) Where a case is legally sufficient to charge a person under the age of eighteen with the crime of false reporting and the alleged offense is the offender's first violation of this section, the prosecutor may divert the case.
- 20 <u>(5) For the purposes of this section, "emergency response" means</u>
  21 <u>any action to protect life, health, or property by:</u>
  - (a) A peace officer or law enforcement agency of the United States, the state, or a political subdivision of the state; or
  - (b) An agency of the United States, the state, or a political subdivision of the state, or a private not-for-profit organization that provides fire, rescue, or emergency medical services.
- 27 (6) Nothing in this section will be construed to: (a) Impose
  28 liability on a person who contacts law enforcement for the purpose
  29 of, or in connection with, the reporting of unlawful conduct; (b)
  30 conflict with Title 47 U.S.C. Sec. 230 of the communication decency
  31 act; or (c) conflict with Title 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1983 of the civil
  32 rights act.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW to read as follows:
- 35 (1) (a) An individual who is a victim of an offense under RCW
  36 9A.84.040 may bring a civil action against the person who committed
  37 the offense or against any person who knowingly benefits, financially
  38 or by receiving anything of value, from participation in a venture
  39 that the person knew or should have known has engaged in an act in

- violation of RCW 9A.84.040, and may recover damages and any other 1 appropriate relief, including reasonable attorneys' fees. 2
  - (b) A person who is found liable under RCW 9A.84.040 shall be jointly and severally liable with each other person, if any, who is found liable under RCW 9A.84.040 for damages arising from the same violation of RCW 9A.84.040.
- (2) Any person convicted of violating RCW 9A.84.040 and that 7 resulted in an emergency response may be liable to a public agency for the reasonable costs of the emergency response by, and at the discretion of, the public agency that incurred the costs.

- <u>EFFECT:</u> (1) Restores the authorization for a city to bring a claim for damages against the perpetrator of a false report for the costs of an emergency response;
- (2) Restores a cause of action against a person who benefited from a false report;
- (3) Authorizes the prosecutor to divert a juvenile case on the first offense only; and
- (4) Adds savings provisions for a person who contacts law enforcement for lawful purposes and states that the provisions shall not be construed to conflict with the Communications Decency Act or Civil Rights Act.
