1 On page 2, after line 33, strike all material down through line 3
2 on page 3 and insert the following:

4 (3) A nontraditional residential address may be used when a voter
5 resides on an Indian reservation or on Indian lands. The address of a
6 tribally designated building that is a ballot pickup and collection
7 location under section 4(4) of this act may serve as the residential
8 address and mailing address for voters living on Indian lands if the
9 tribally designated building is in the same precinct as the voter. If
10 the designated tribal government building is not in the same precinct
11 as the voter, the voter may use the designated tribal government
12 building as a mailing address, but must separately designate the
13 voter's appropriate residential for precincting purposes through a
14 nontraditional address.

15 EFFECT: Allows voters with nontraditional address to use the tribally designated building address as a residential address for precincting purposes if they are in the same precinct. Allows voters outside the precinct to use the tribally designated facility for their mailing address, but designate the precinct that appropriately corresponds to their nontraditional address.
