5 financial need and other considerations such as whether the student
6 is a former foster youth."

7 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any
8 internal references accordingly.

9 On page 4, line 9, after "(2)" strike all material through "RCW
10 28B.92.030" on line 19 and insert "Students with family incomes
11 between zero and fifty percent of the state median family income may
12 be eligible to receive the maximum Washington college promise
13 scholarship award as defined in RCW 28B.92.030. Awards for students
14 with incomes between fifty-one and seventy percent of the state
15 median family income shall be prorated at the following percentages
16 of the maximum Washington college promise scholarship award amount
17 granted to those with incomes below fifty-one percent of the state
18 median family income"

19 On page 4, beginning on line 20, strike all of subsection (2)(a)

20 Reletter the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any
21 internal references accordingly.

22 Beginning on page 6, line 29, strike all of part II

23 Renumber the remaining part and sections consecutively and
24 correct any internal references accordingly.

25 On page 41, line 33, after "**Sec. 34.**" strike "Sections 1 through
26 4 and 7 through 33 of this act take" and insert "This act takes"
