7 On page 9, beginning on line 15, after "to" strike all material
8 through "person" on line 16 and insert "provide the person with
9 information on how to submit evidence of inability to pay and request
10 a payment plan"

11 On page 10, line 3, after "~~has~~)" insert "failed to set up or
12 comply with the terms of a payment plan,"

13 On page 11, line 5, after "~~court,~~)" insert "failed to set up or
14 comply with the terms of a payment plan,"

15 On page 17, line 38, after "~~court,~~)" insert "failed to set up or
16 comply with the terms of a payment plan,"

17 On page 22, line 11, after "violation," insert "fails to set up
18 or comply with the terms of a payment plan,"

EFFECT: Only requires the court to enter into a payment plan with an individual if the obligation has not been referred to a collections agency for civil enforcement; prior to referring an obligation for collection, requires the court provide a person with information on how to submit evidence of inability to pay and request a payment plan rather than attempt to enter into a payment plan; shortens the time period from 120 days to 45 days from the date of the infraction before the court can refer the obligation to a collections agency; authorizes driver's license suspension for an individual who fails to set up a payment plan or comply with the

terms of a payment plan for any monetary obligation owing as a result of a traffic infraction for a moving violation.
