- AN ACT Relating to protecting state and federal monuments, memorials, and statues from damage intentionally inflicted during the
- 3 course of unpeaceful demonstrations or riots; amending RCW 9A.48.110;
- 4 and prescribing penalties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.48.110 and 1995 c 66 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:
- 8 (1) A person is guilty of defacing a ((state)) <u>public</u> monument if 9 he or she knowingly defaces a <u>statue</u>, monument, or memorial on the 10 state capitol campus, or other ((state)) property <u>owned by a public</u> 11 body.
- (2) For purposes of this section, "public body" means the federal government and the state of Washington, its agencies, institutions, political subdivisions, and municipal and quasi-municipal corporations now or hereafter existing under the laws of the state of
- 16 Washington.
- 17 (3) Defacing a ((state)) public monument is a gross misdemeanor.
