> Requires the Department of Licensing (DOL) to make EFFECT: recommendations on a licensure program for independent repair providers who provide the services of diagnosis, maintenance, and repair of digital electronic equipment, with a report on the recommendations due to the legislature by October 31, 2023. Makes the effective date of the Fair Repair Act contingent on the legislature adopting a licensing program for independent repair providers.
