1 On page 2, after line 13, insert the following:

2 "(e)(i) The information listed in (d) of this subsection that is
3 located in any record or system concerning an agency employee or their
4 dependent that is held or maintained by the employee's employing
5 agency if the employee has provided to the agency:

6 (A) A sworn statement, signed under penalty of perjury that the
7 employee or a dependent of the employee is a survivor of domestic
8 violence as defined in RCW 10.99.020 or 7.105.010, sexual assault as
9 defined in RCW 70.125.030 or sexual abuse as defined in
10 RCW 7.105.010, stalking as described in RCW 9A.46.110 or defined in
11 RCW 7.105.010, or harassment as described in RCW 9A.46.020 or
12 defined in RCW 7.105.010; or

13 (B) Proof of the employee's participation or the participation
14 of a dependent in the address confidentiality program under
15 chapter 40.24 RCW.

16 (ii) For purposes of (i) of this subsection only:

17 (A) "Employee" means an employee of an agency defined under (B)
18 of this subsection, and legislators.

19 (B) "Agency" has the same meaning as in RCW 42.56.010, but also
20 includes the office of the secretary of the senate and the office of
21 the chief clerk of the house of representatives."

23 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct
24 any internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Exempts certain personal information, such as residential addresses, residential phone numbers, and driver's license numbers, concerning an agency employee or their dependent that is held or maintained by the employee's employing agency if the employee provides proof that they or their dependent are a:

(1) survivor of domestic violence, sexual assault, sexual abuse, stalking, or harassment; or

(2) participant in the Address Confidentiality Program.

Specifies that, for the purpose of this exemption only, the exemption also applies to legislators and "agency" includes the Office of the Secretary of the Senate and the Office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives.
